As Engineering Services Manager, I managed reservoir, operations, construction and drilling engineering functions that supported the international business units. Projects included CDX Field in China, Alba Phase 2 Development in Equatorial Guinea and Machala Power Plant in Ecuador. Prior to that, I was the project engineer for the Machala Power Plant and Amistad Field development in Ecuador.

Accomplishments include:

- Completed development of Amistad Field and installation of Machala Power Plant in Ecuador utilizing offshore gas to fuel a 130 MWh power plant.
- Managed start-up of CDX Field offshore China for a winter start-up.
- Met with Ministry representatives for the government of Equatorial Guinea on numerous projects including the Alba Phase 2 Development, Ampco Methanol Plant, Alba LPG Plant and plans for EG LNG Plant.
- Proposed the conversion of a gas injection pipeline to gas production, delaying the necessity of a major compression project.

- Additional development of Yombo Field shallow oil reservoirs using horizontal wells, upgrade of the Yombo FPSO and interfacing with the Congolese Government.
- Development of the El Franig and Baguel Fields in central Tunisia using a central processing facility and over 100 km of pipeline. This project was a greenfield development requiring significant interfacing with the national gas company.
- Additional development in Alba Field off Equatorial Guinea including estimation of reserves, upgrading facilities and the Phase 1 Acceleration Project.
